



The East Asian Weed Science Congress in Commemoration of 30th Anniversary of KSWS

The Korean Society of Weed Science hosts an International Weed Science Congress named “The East Asian Weed Science Congress” in commemoration of her 30th anniversary. The Congress will focus on the most common and important topics in the East Asian countries, i.e., herbicide resistance, integrated weed management, and new technology in weed science. Key weed scientists invited from China, Japan and Korea will give invaluable speeches. We also encourage presentation of scientific papers in oral and poster sessions.

Jeju, where the Congress will be held, is the most prestigious exotic island and the first tourist attraction in Korea. Jeju is a volcanic island, 130 km from the southern coast of Korea. The largest island and smallest province in Korea, the island has a surface area of 1,846 km². A central feature of Jeju is Hallasan, the tallest mountain in South Korea and a dormant volcano, which rises 1,950 m above sea level. Three hundred sixty satellite volcanoes are around the main volcano. Its unique and well-reserved nature has made Jeju selected as Biosphere Reserve in 2002, World Natural Heritage in 2007 and Global Geo-park in 2010. Jeju is now nominated as one of the final candidates of the New 7Wonders of Nature (see <http://www.new7wonders.com/>). Visa is exempted for visitors from other countries as Jeju is only one special self-governing province in Korea. Therefore, Jeju welcomes all the participants from overseas and will provide comfortable stay with unforgettable memory during the Congress. 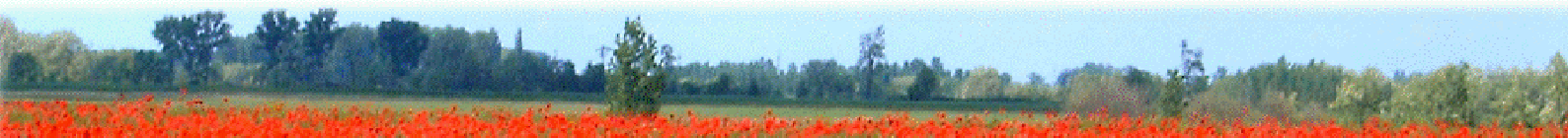
Abstract & Paper Submission

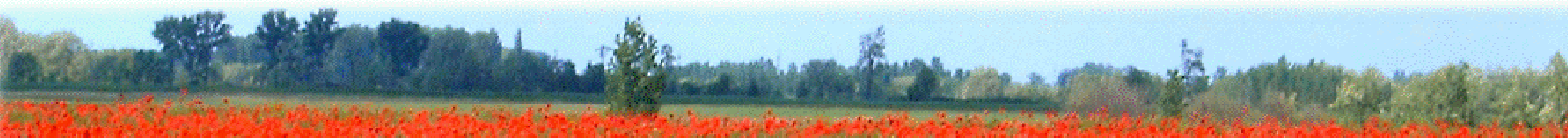
What to See in Jeju

What are the New7Wonders of Nature?

The New7Wonders Foundation in Switzerland has initiated a second transnational project to pick the world's seven most wonderful natural sites. In 2007, under the foundation's first project, it selected the "Seven Wonders of the World" with the participation of 100 million internet users.

Jeju is one of the 28 finalists for the New7Wonders of Nature! And it is the only candidate site where human, nature and pre-historic relics coexist harmoniously in a single location.

- First voting: 261 tourist sites were picked among 440 worldwide (Dec.31, 2008)
- Second Voting: 77 candidate sites representing the seven categories were chosen (July 7, 2009)
- The New7Wonders: Experts of the New7Wonders Foundation selected the final 28 candidate sites through screening (July 21, 2009)
- Voting is under way worldwide via telephone and through the internet. **The voting deadline is Nov. 10, 2011** (about 1 billion people are expected to participate in the poll)
